Norval Morrisseau's work resides in the permanent collections of the National Gallery of Canada, the Smithsonian Museum of American Indian Art (New York), Art Gallery of Ontario, the Heard Museum (Arizona), and most museums of note across Canada. Maslak McLeod Gallery is now offering you the opportunity to add to your own personal collection a Morrisseau of similar quality to those held in these great museums. These rare works, many of which were acquired early with clear provenance and, in some cases, a single owner, are highly prized and of a standard of excellence rarely encountered in the marketplace.

If in the future, a single artist will represent a time, a people, and an artistic movement, it will be Norval Morrisseau, Copper Thunderbird. Just as the Group of Seven exemplifies a time and spirit of Canada in the early 20th century, native art - and particularly the Woodland School - will stand for the late 20th and early 21st century. This summer, the gallery is featuring early and mid-career works by Morrisseau, with a broad spectrum of choice and diverse media.
